The Nigeria Governors' Forum High-Level Roundtable


WHAT IS IT?

At the roundtable, states will discuss ways to enhance energy access, while listening to input from experts in subnational electricity markets.




WHO WILL BE THERE?


WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?
